It is difficult to explain what the **Vivanco Museum of the Culture of Wine** is and what it has to offer. We believe that, to get to know it, it is best to come and see it. Because they are **4,000 m2 and six rooms**, one exterior, devoted to valuing the relationship between man and wine over 8,000 years of history, with pieces collected by my family for over 40 years.

The Museum, **respected as one of the great icons of the Culture of Wine in the world**, was created with the aim to educate, disseminate and interact with wine as a civilizing element. And all made from experience, sensitivity, respect and innovation.

Room 1.

Being born, Growing, Maturing

The route starts in the first room, where we contextualise the origin of the wine. Where and why it all started. We stroll through different cultures and we stop to look at grape growing, at what happens in a vineyard throughout the year, at the machinery used by man, at its pests and threats. At the harvest and its people. At the winemaking process. All of it in a visual and creative way.

Room 2.

Save the essences

We could say that, after the first room, visitors will know how wine is made and what is needed to make it. In this room, we look at the wine industry suppliers. At the barrel and its importance in ageing wine. At glass and the historical evolution of the bottle. And at cork, its industry and evolution. All of it through three impressive educational audiovisual presentations. Have you ever seen how a cooper makes a barrel? And how glass is blown to make a bottle? And how cork plugs are made? Here you will discover it all.

Room 3.

The Winery: the dream

The winery and its work now take the centre stage. Pressings, rackings, clarifications and

filterings. All that is needed to make a good wine. Then comes the sales work, the journey of wine: amphorae, skins, bottles, carts... they have brought wine to the ends of the Earth to turn it into something universal.

Room 4.

The Wine: art and symbol

Our most special room. How did man come to understand wine and how did he shape it? Wine had and continues to have a symbolic value with an important cultural dimension. The art and archaeology collection brings together works from different periods and styles who share this common denominator. Even films have a place in this room. Here you will find to Picasso, Dürer, Miró, Sorolla, Juan Gris, Barceló, Mantegna, Dalí, Tàpies... All of them also fell in love with wine. And reflected this in their artworks. Here you can enjoy all their work.

Room 5.

Open, serve and drink

Did you know that there are more than 3,000 different ways to open a bottle of wine? Here you can find out how. In our corkscrew collection. 3.000 models with different backgrounds and personalities. Seems simple, but... We also do a full review of wine pouring.



Containers, serving instruments, wineglasses... It is all there, so you can know how it has evolved historically.

Room 6.

The Garden of Bacchus

Wine has many faces represented in each of the grape varieties used to make it. Here, in an outer room, you can discover a collection of more than 200 different grapes. From Spain and from all over the world.
